



What We Often See

- Shining Makes Us Uncomfortable
 - We Don't Want Attention
 - We Don't Want To Be Seen As A Hypocrite

Matthew 6:2, 5; 23:3, 5



What We Often See

- Shining Might Offend Some
 - Some Are Comfortable As They Are
 - Some Prefer Darkness

Prov. 4:19; John. 3:19, 20



What We Often See

- Shining Is For Others
 - We Feel Unqualified/Inadequate
 - We Don't Understand "Shine"

- We Don't Think We Need To Shine
 - You ARE The Light

We Don't Consider Our Influence

- Our Light Is Dimmed
 - We Don't Want To Be T00 Bright
 - No One Takes Notice



- Our Light Is Inconsistent
 - Not Always 'On'
 - A Confusing Signal
